EMERGENCY CLOSING OF SCHOOL DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER: On rare occasions, emergency conditions such as an impending blizzard, etc., may necessitate the dismissal of children **BEFORE** the regular closing time. In order to insure that your child will be properly cared for please advise us of any emergency arrangements that will be necessary.

TRANSPORTATION: Parents will be notified of approximate time of pick-up, before the first day of classes. It is important that your child is ready to leave when the bus arrives and, on the return trip, that someone is available to receive the child as he/she leaves the vehicle. **NO** child will be left without adult acknowledgment. Please understand, should the bus be delayed, that with young children unforeseen problems can always arise.

MESSAGES: In case of absence, please notify the school no later than **one hour** before your child is to be picked up by the bus, so that we can inform the bus driver. If you wish your child to be picked up or dropped off at another child's house, it is important that you **call** to make bus arrangements with the school. **Seats may not be available on other buses.**

MEDICINE: If medicine is sent to school, it **MUST** be sent in the **ORIGINAL CONTAINER, please include a Doctor's note and Medication Consent Form** (this is State Law). Include very specific directions as to time to be taken and amount. **DO NOT** send more medicine than is needed for the time in school.

VISITING: Parents, please remember when visiting your child, to check in at the **OFFICE** before going to the classroom.
